We are writing to provide you an update on our recent open house and to invite you to our next community meeting for the proposed Skyview 2 Battery Energy Storage project (the "Project"). The Project is proposed to be located near existing transmission lines north of Dobbie Road where it will store electricity from the grid in lithium-ion batteries and then provide the energy back to the grid when it's needed most; a map of the proposed project is enclosed, additional information is available on our website (www.skyview2bess.ca).
